

Oral presentation

You will have 20 minutes to individually present your topic. Presentations should be kept simple. They can consist of figures directly from the literature (with proper attribution) and verbal descriptions of the background, experiments, results, and future directions of several recent studies in a research area. You should have no more than 10 slides. You are also encouraged to directly follow the points mentioned in your written Wiki page. You should also reference one key research paper that the rest of the class will read during the week after seeing your presentation. Don't discuss that paper in detail at this time. Do provide the background leading up to that paper by discussing other research papers.
